## Winter Bible Conference 2007

Imagine, if you would, that you grew up in a very small world. You've never been outside your state, quite possibly never been to the next town, much less New York or Chicago. Imagine also, that in this small world—the only one you've ever experienced—there is another aspect that makes your world even smaller: you are one of maybe 20-30 believers in Jesus that you have ever met.

In the month of January, we had the incredible privilege to take part in taking 15 young people over 1500 miles to St. Petersburg for our Winter Bible Conference. Here, over 300 university students and staff gathered from all over Russia to worship, pray, hear Bible teaching, and be trained in how they can be a part of reaching their campuses for Christ. For the six believers from Nalchik, this is the largest gathering of believers they have ever seen.



This summer, Busan, South Korea will host the largest student missions conference in history. 20,000 students from over 100 countries will meet to pray and seek God and will be challenged to launch new movements on the unreached campuses of the world.

Students from Nalchik have been challenged to be a part of this conference and reaching the world for Christ. Abbie and I have been asked to take 3 – 5 students from Nalchik. Please start praying!
