Connected Movements: Imagine a small group of students from a certain dorm who are committed to sharing their faith with their lost friends. Through their witness, some international students are won to Jesus and begin sharing Christ among the international students on campus. Through their witness, a Turkish student comes to Jesus. He goes back to Turkey as a businessman, and now shares Christ with his co-workers. This is what we mean when we say "Movement!"

Learning how to develop movements of disciple-making evangelists who are able to lead and teach others was key at CM 2007. We pray that from university campuses, movements will grow to influence other campuses, businesses, governments, orphanages, militaries, etc.—all for Christ's glory around the world!

Completing the Mission: We identified 8,000 of the most influential campuses in the world. Of these, only about 2,000 have a witness for Christ. Students were challenged to GO to the unreached! Can you imagine the impact of 17,000 lives surrendered to Christ and committed to going?

Murat, the student from Nalchik, was one of those impacted in a life-changing way. By the second day of the conference, he was ready to pack his bags and head to the Middle East! We challenged him to help us raise up a team of people from Nalchik to go to the Muslim world. This is the kind of influence we are praying the conference continues to have in Murat's life, and in the lives of the students who attended.
